The undersigned is directed to refer to letter No. 20-4/2010-CIR dated 08.10.2010 of the Secretariat of Central Insecticides Board & Registration Committee and convey the approval of competent authority in Department of Agriculture & Cooperation provisionally for use of the following insecticides for control of various pests of grapes by the National Research Center for Grapes, Pune of the Indian Council of Agricultural Research as recommended by the Registration Committee in its 312<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 24.09.2010:

(i) Fipronil 80% WG

(ii) Emamectin Benzoate 5% SG

(iii) Fenpyroximate 5% SC (iv) Imidacloprid 70% WG

(iv) Imidacloprid 70% WG (v) Spinosad 45% SC

(vi) Clothianidin 50% WDG (vii) Lamda-cyhalothrin 5% EC

(viii) Lamda-cyhalothrin 5% EC (viii) Imidacloprid 17.8% SL

(ix) Thiamethoxam 25% WG

This approval is valid for a period of one year at the end of which further extension of the arrangement would be decided based on progress made in generation of data for label expansion. Further, the maximum level of pesticide residues shall be the limit of detection.
